South Haven Public School Election: May 6, 2014

South Haven Public School will have an election on Tuesday, May 6, 2014.

Absentee ballots are available from your city or township clerk if you meet one of the following conditions:

- Are 60 years of age or older.
- Expect to be absent from the community in which you are registered to vote for the entire time the polls are open on election day.
- Are physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another.
- Cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of your religion.
- Have been appointed as an election inspector in a precinct other than the precinct in which you reside.
- Cannot attend the polls because you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial.



An application must be filed with the Clerk's Office in your jurisdiction to obtain an absentee ballot. For City residents, applications are available on the City's website at www.south-haven.com or at City Hall.

The City of South Haven Clerk's Office will be open from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. each day to issue Absentee Ballots. In addition, the City of South Haven Clerk's Office will be open at City Hall from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 3, 2014 for issuing absentee ballots. Please call your city or township clerk for more information on Absentee Ballots or the election.



Just a few reminders...

- Beginning on November 15th, there is no parking allowed on any City street between 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. to allow for snow removal. This parking restriction will be in effect until March 15, 2014.
- The City of South Haven mailed the Winter 2013 Property Tax bills the first week of December. If you have not received your bill please call (269) 637-0700 or visit the Parcel Records area of the City's website at www.south-haven.com. Winter taxes are due on February 14th.
- You may notice that all bills from the City now contain a barcode. Please make sure to bring your bill with you when you make a payment to ensure proper posting of your payment and to expedite your service.
- Trash containers should not be placed in the parkway more than 24 hours before pick-up. Also, the containers shall be removed no more than 24 hours following pick-up.

Effective Monday, March 31st, 2014 the Dyckman Avenue Bascule Bridge will operate from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on the hour and half-hour, Monday through Thursday. On Friday the bridge will operate from 7:00 a.m. to midnight on the hour and the half-hour.

Effective Friday, March 31st, 2014 the bridge will operate as follows:

Monday - Thursday:	7:00 a.m. - 11:00 p.m.
Friday:	7:00 a.m. - midnight
Saturday - Sunday:	6:00 a.m. - midnight
Holidays	6:00 a.m. - midnight
