


## WIFI SYSTEM UPDATE FOR DOWNTOWN AND CITY MARINAS

The Phoenix Street Improvement project included installation of free wifi access to downtown users. In conjunction with this project, the City marinas will also receive wifi access. The wifi system is a package deal of which fifty-five percent (55%) of the total cost of the project of \$212,182, or \$116,700, will be funded by the DDA. The city marina fund will pay 45% or \$95,482.

Secant Technologies has been contracted by the city to design the wifi system. Bloomingdale Communications is the internet service provider who will deliver new fiber circuits and reconfigure the existing fiber circuits to the sites. Currently, they are awaiting new equipment which is expected to arrive mid-July; then installation will take place. Once this work is complete, the anticipated operational date of free wifi service to the designated areas is July 31st.

## Just a few reminders...

- The City of South Haven Code of Ordinance states that trash containers may be placed on the curb no more than 24 hours prior to trash pick-up, and removed no more than 24 hours after trash pick-up.
- Please note the following excerpts from the City's Zoning Ordinance regarding signs:
  - \* Signs not exceeding six (6) square feet advocating for or against a particular political cause or candidate for political office, within sixty (60) days prior to an election. Such signs shall be removed within fourteen (14) days after an election and may not be placed in any public right-of-way.
  - \* Signs not greater than four (4) square feet in area advertising a temporary condition such as a garage sale and erected for not more than seven (7) days in a four (4) month period.
- Every person who owns, occupies or leases any land within the city must cut, destroy, and remove all noxious and poisonous weeds growing on the property, as well as dead grass and brush. The resident must also prevent grass from growing in excess of six inches in height.
- You may notice that all bills from the City now contain a barcode. Please make sure to bring your bill with you when you make a payment to ensure proper posting of your payment and to expedite your service.
