Dyckman Bridge Reconstruction Update

The Dyckman Bridge Reconstruction project is moving along as scheduled. Recently crews have completed the construction of the new storm sewer from the Black River to Park Avenue and installed underdrains, sand subbase and gravel base for the new road from the bridge to Black River Street.

Over the coming weeks, crews will complete the remaining storm sewer at the Park Avenue intersection and will install the remaining underdrains, sand subbase, and gravel base for the new road from Black River Street to Park Avenue.

Once these activities are completed, the contractor plans to shut down operations for the winter. During the winter shut down, Dyckman Avenue will still be closed. However, the intersection of Park & Dyckman and the intersection of Black River Street & Dyckman will be open to through traffic once again.



Just a few reminders...

... Beginning on November 15th, there is no parking allowed on any City street between 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. to allow for snow removal. This parking restriction will be in effect until March 15, 2015.

... Trash containers should not be placed in the parkway more than 24 hours before pick-up. Also, the containers shall be removed no more than 24 hours following pick-up.
