The remodel of the Customer Service Area that began March 6th was completed on March 16th. This remodel was the third part of a set of plans for renovations to City Hall. The renovations to the Customer Service Area included improvements to allow for additional work areas and increased security of the office.



Construction Continues on Optimist Tot Lot

Improvements to the restrooms at the city's Optimist Tot Lot continue. The intent is to improve accessibility and upgrade the fixtures. Construction will involve removing the existing roof structure for reuse, removing walls and replacing them with new masonry walls, as well as the installing new doors. The contractor, Olson Brothers Company, has completed the demolition portion and continues to make progress towards project completion. The scheduled completion date is May 25, 2015, Memorial Day.

Spring Cleanup Reminder

The City of South Haven will be running a spring leaf pick up April 20th through May 1st. To assist the city street crew, please rake your leaves to the parkway (the area between the sidewalk and the street).

a leaf truck is a large vehicle and cannot turn around easily. The street crew will complete one side of the street and come back to do the other side, which may occur on a different day.

Please do not rake them into the street. Doing so will clog the storm drains and also make it difficult for the leaf truck to pick-up your leaves.

After May1st all lawn debris must be placed in approved lawn bags and branches must be bundled up and tied in 3ft long bundles. This can then be placed out on the normal garbage collection day and will be taken away by Republic Disposal.
