Parking Lot Construction Begins

On March 21, 2016, City Council approved the bid award for the construction of parking lots at the former Baars printing site in the Huron Street parking lot and at Black River Park on Dunkley Avenue. The City was awarded \$30,000 from the USDA Rural Development to assist in project costs.

Construction will begin on April 11, 2016. All work will be substantially completed on both projects by May 27, 2016; however, the work on the Huron Street lot will be completed by May 20, 2016.

Krohn Excavating LLC was awarded the Black River Park RBEG Parking Lot and the Huron Street DDA Parking Lot. The breakdown of the bid award is as follows:

Black River Park: \$98,630.00

Alternate #1: \$83,555.85

Alternate #2: \$22,885.00

Huron Street \$173,048.55

Total contract award of \$378,119.40

Spring Cleanup Reminder

The City of South Haven will be running a spring leaf pick up beginning March 28th. To assist the city street crew, please rake your leaves to the parkway (the area between the sidewalk and the street).

Please do not rake them into the street. Doing so will clog the storm drains and also make it difficult for the leaf truck to pick-up your leaves.

Please be patient during the spring cleanup process and remember that a leaf truck is a large vehicle and cannot turn around easily. The street crew will complete one side of the street and come back to do the other side, which may occur on a different day.

After May 27th all lawn debris must be placed in approved lawn bags and branches must be bundled up and tied in 3ft long bundles. This can then be placed out on the normal garbage collection day and will be taken away by Republic Disposal.
