CHANGES TO TALL GRASS AND NOXIOUS WEEDS ENFORCEMENT

The City of South Haven will again be enforcing the City Code of Ordinances regulating tall grasses and weeds (Sections 30-92 through 30-94). Please note that there have been changes to this program from previous years.

Property owners or other responsible party having grass or weeds taller than nine (9) inches will be notified by mail that they have five (5) days to cut and remove any tall grasses, noxious weeds and miscellaneous debris. **There will no longer be any courtesy notices mailed.**

If the owner or responsible party should fail to comply with this order, the code enforcement officer for the city will authorize the mowing and removal of all tall grasses (except dune grasses), noxious weeds and other miscellaneous debris. The amount of fee shall equal the cost of performing the work (\$85.00 for a residential lot) and an administrative fee of \$150.00.

A FEW REMINDERS FOR SPRING LEAF PICK-UP AND ELECTRIC POWER OUTAGES

The City of South Haven has begun spring leaf pick up, to assist the city street crew, please rake your leaves to the parkway (the area between the sidewalk and the street).

Please do not rake them into the street. Doing so will clog the storm drains and also make it difficult for the leaf truck to pick-up your leaves. Please be patient during the spring cleanup process and remember that a leaf truck is a large vehicle and cannot turn around easily. The street crew will complete one side of the street and come back to do the other side, which may occur on a different day.

Spring showers are often accompanied by severe weather. During this time of year, crews are often out repairing damage from storms. Our electric department works hard to keep our power on with minimal disruption. If your power goes out, please notify us immediately.
