## General Election: November 8, 2016

The general election will be held in the basement of City Hall from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, November 8, 2016.**

Absentee ballots are available if you meet one of the following conditions:

- Are 60 years of age or older;
- Expect to be absent from the community in which you are registered to vote for the entire time the polls are open on election day;
- Are physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another;
- Cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of your religion;
- Have been appointed as an election inspector in a precinct other than the precinct in which you reside; or
- Cannot attend the polls because you are confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial.

An application must be on file with the Clerk's office in your jurisdiction to obtain an absentee ballot. For City residents, applications are available at City Hall or on the city's website at [www.south-haven.com/pages/clerk/election\\_main.html](http://www.south-haven.com/pages/clerk/election_main.html)

The Clerk's Office will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day to issue Absentee Ballots. In addition, the Clerk's Office will be open at City Hall from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 5, 2016 for issuing absentee ballots. Please call the City Clerk at (269) 637-0750 for more information on Absentee Ballots or the election.

## Register to Vote by October 11, 2016

**\*The last day to register to vote for the November 8, 2016 General Election is Tuesday, October 11, 2016.**
