BOIL WATER NOTIFICATION

On Wednesday April 19th, 2017, the City of South Haven along with Milbockers INC, will have a temporary shutdown of the water main on Dunkley Ave to relocate existing water main to allow for installation of the new sewer main. The addresses of 144 and 132 Dunkley will be in the affected work area and will have no water during this shut down.

- Dunkley Ave

It is anticipated that water service will be restored to the affected areas no later than 5:00 PM on Wednesday April 19th, 2017.

Due to the reduction of water pressure within the affected service area, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) requires our public water system, City of South Haven, WSSN 06100 to notify customers to boil their water prior to consumption. This boil water notice affects all customers in South Haven Township within the service area listed above.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and for making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from an alternate suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. The rescind notice will be issued in the same manner as this Boil Water Notice. The City is required to perform bacteriological testing over a 72 hour period prior to rescinding this notice. Assuming acceptable testing, the soonest that the notice may be lifted is during the day Friday.
