North Shore Drive Project

Over the past week, our Contractor has finished the mainline sidewalk within our Phase III (Brockway to Baseline) area. We have also set/installed the new beach access signs at the Dyckman, Packard, Oak, and Newcome Beach access sites. Approximately ¾ of the curb & gutter was also placed earlier this week within Phase III. The remaining curb work on the project is projected to be completed today/tomorrow. Other miscellaneous work has consisted of some grading of the gravel base, and some topsoil placement on the south half of the project, near Dyckman Avenue.

As mentioned above, Duran Concrete will be finishing the curb & gutter work in Phase III today or tomorrow. Once complete, our work will transition into concrete drive aprons between the sidewalk and the curb & gutter. This work is expected to start as soon as tomorrow (Thursday, June 8th) and last though the rest of this week.





<u>Please Note:</u> As new concrete (sidewalks, curbs, and driveways) are being placed in our Phase III area, it is extremely important to give the concrete a change to cure. Foot traffic is fine after a day, but vehicular traffic needs to be avoided for a period of 4-5 days to obtain proper strength.

Other potential work for the upcoming week includes final grading of the aggregate base course and some light restoration/topsoil work. On-going utility relocation work by Kent Power, Comcast and Frontier Communications should also be expected.

Looking a bit further down the road, our first layer of asphalt pavement (the base course) is tentatively scheduled for Friday, June 16th. The intermediate layer (the leveling course) is tentatively scheduled for the Monday after, June 19th.

Finally, weekly on-site "tailgate talks" continue to take place for anyone with specific project related questions. These meetings take place on Wednesday's at 9:30 a.m. on the sidewalk in front of North Side Memories on Dyckman Avenue.
