North Shore Drive Project

Over the past week, Milbocker & Sons has completed removals of the existing concrete pavement, curb & gutter, and driveway aprons within the Phase III (Brockway to Baseline) area. The road is currently in a gravel state and remains accessible to local residents & property owners within the Phase III area.


The unseasonably warm weather for November has resulted in great progress made this week. The Contractor was able to complete all proposed water services and sanitary laterals to properties within the Phase II (Dyckman to Brockway) area. They have also started the mainline sanitary sewer in our Phase III (Brockway to Baseline) area. This work has initiated at Brockway Avenue and will continue to advance north toward Baseline Road.

Currently, the Contractor is working toward completion of the proposed storm sewer system within the Phase II area.



Approximately 150' of 12" diameter storm sewer remains to be installed in this portion of the job.

Next week, the Contractor will be working on storm sewer laterals to east side properties within Phase II (Dyckman to Brockway), mainline sanitary sewer in Phase III (Brockway to Baseline), and will continue the proposed storm sewer installation at the end of Newcome Street.



Other potential work for next week includes starting sanitary service laterals within Phase III near Brockway Avenue. During installation of your new sanitary service lateral, access to your driveway will be interrupted until the excavation & backfill work is complete.

The side street water main connection work that was mentioned last week has been pushed off until December 6th due to our pressure testing and chlorination taking longer than expected.

For anyone with specific project related questions, weekly on-site "tailgate talks" continue to take place on Wednesday's at 9:30 a.m. These meetings take place on the sidewalk in front of North Side Memories on Dyckman Avenue.
