

Senior Equipment Operator

The City of South Haven is seeking a Senior Equipment Operator. Responsibilities include performing a variety of more difficult and responsible public works construction and maintenance activities involving the safe and efficient operation of heavy duty and other automotive and power-driven equipment.

Typical duties and responsibilities:

- As a major assignment, to operate any power-driven equipment, which may include a pay loader, snow plow, street sweeper, street excavator, backhoe, or other designated equipment.
- To perform the more responsible and more difficult work in street maintenance.
- To install and maintain water and sewer mains, and associated fittings.
- To perform required concrete work for the construction and maintenance of public works systems.
- Replace, repair, and read water meters, and record readings, also flow check meters for accuracy and code compliance.
- To comply with all safety standards and procedures.
- To perform routine maintenance and inspection on vehicles and equipment.
- Perform related work as required.
- Perform work of lower rated employees.

Qualifications:

High school diploma or equivalent; knowledge of the operation and maintenance of various types of heavy-duty equipment and vehicles; knowledge of methods, materials and equipment used in water, sewer and street system maintenance and construction; minimum of one year of relevant experience.

Must have good driving record, possess valid Michigan driver's license and be able to obtain a CDL.
